
Analysis of Exit Feedback from 2015-2019 batch

Out of 51 students 45.1% students had backlog during the course. Average GPA of the batch is 7.33 till VII semester.




2. Courses that has been found difficult

3. Competitive Exam






5. Any comment/suggestion in view of the betterment of syllabus/course curriculum, other facilities:

Below gives the summary of the comments from students:


- Laboratory equipment system are very old for present lab experiment & performance, Labs should be more innovative with latest equipment's.

- Construction management and BIM should be taught hand in hand


