The meeting started with the opening address of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, and which was followed by discussions on following Agendas:

105.02. Confirmation of Minutes of the 104th Meeting.

To confirm the Minutes of the 104th Meeting of the Academic Council held on 6th November 2020 at 3.00 P.M. in the Institute Conference Hall.

Resolution: Confirmed.

105.03. Proposal from Dean (PGS) and Dean (UGS)

Dean (PGS) and Dean (UGS) proposed the following agenda:

a) Academic Advisors Policy.

- i. Each department shall have Academic Advisors (program coordinators) for all the UG and PG program, who in coordination with the Student Advisor (for a group of 20 students) shall advise the respective students for their registration to the specific courses, minors, specializations, open electives, MOOCs, etc. before the beginning of each Semester.
- ii. Each Advisor needs to display all the information on the Departmental Notice Board, regarding such program to avoid any confusion related to such issues.
- iii. Coordinators for MOOC to be appointed at Institute level.

Resolution: Approved.

- b) Engagement of other Institutions/industries with BIT Academics. Engagement of BIT and its other campuses with other Institutes of Repute (IoR) in the field of Science, Management, and Engineering Research, such as IITs, NITs, IIITs, IISERs, Central Universities, etc., and established industries for the following purposes:
 - i. Joint PhD guidance
 - ii. Joint PG guidance
 - iii. Joint R & D projects
 - iv. Participation in BOS
 - v. Joint publications
 - vi. Set up of laboratories with support from industry such as Free scale, HP, Intel, Samsung, Dr. Reddy, Siemens etc.

Resolution: Approved.

c) Plagiarism Policy.

- i. Mandatory for all the project reports and theses at all levels (B. Tech, M. Tech and Ph.D.) using widely acceptable Software such as iTHenticate, etc.
- ii. UGC's anti-plagiarism policy allows up to 10% content similarity (Excluding own paper, references, etc.)

Resolution: Approved.

d) UG/PG Project Guidance and Guide Allocation Policy.

- i. All faculty members should get at least one student/group to guide.
- ii. Wherever, the number of students/groups is less than the number of faculty, joint guidance should be encouraged to involve all the faculty members in student's guidance.
- iii. A student's group consisting of 3 students may be formed with two students only to distribute the student groups to all the faculty members.

Resolution: Approved.

e) MOOC Guideline Policy.

- i. MOOCs should be optional depending on the necessity of a particular department/Campus.
- ii. The credit assigned would depend on the number of weeks (8 or 12: 8-week course may be assigned 2 credits while 12 weeks as 3 credits).
- iii. The evaluation should be done strictly by the respective agency and the credit obtained should be transferred to the student's grade card.
- iv. In case a student fails to complete the MOOC successfully, he/she may be permitted to register in same or another MOOC running in the next semester.

- v. In case both are not possible then the student may opt for Open Elective. In all the UG/PG programme, the MOOC shall be optional and not compulsory.
- vi. The fee for obtaining the certificate shall be paid by the student.

Resolution: Approved. The selection of courses from any MOOC Platform shall be decided by the Course Coordinator.

f) MOOC for Ph. D. Scholars.

- i. The Ph. D. scholars may be allowed to take up ONE MOOC (of PG level of 12-week duration only, preferably from SWAYAM portal) if the suggested course work by the doctoral committee is like the courses available on the SWAYAM portal.
- ii. In such cases, the credit earned by the scholars shall be directly transferred to their Grade Card.

Resolution: Approved. The selection of courses from any MOOC Platform shall be decided by the Course Coordinator. The credit equivalence of the MOOC courses shall be decided by the DUGS/ DPGS.

- g) Joint / Collaborative Guidance Policy Inter Institutes / Departmental.
 - i. Joint /collaborative guidance should be encouraged between the two Institutes with or without MOU.
 - ii. NOC to be obtained from respective Institute/ Organization and IPR issues to be addressed properly.
 - iii. Interdepartmental guidance should be promoted based on the project/thesis requirements.

Resolution: Approved. Whatever goes for publication out of the collaborative work must comply with the Regulations of BIT Mesra.

h) Internships for External Students.

- i. Applications may be invited from the students at all recognized Indian institutes for pursuing summer internship at BIT, Mesra and its off campuses during summer break.
- ii. Each department shall provide the list of the topics and available stipend if any. Student's project money (should be with dept. for its optimum utility) may be utilized for this purpose.
- iii. Selected interns will have to pay the hostel fee if they stay at the students' hostels of the institute. They are requested to

mention that they need accommodation while filling up the application form.

- iv. Selected interns may avail mess facility of the student's hostel or canteen of the institute by paying on daily basis during their stay.
- v. STIPENDS will be provided to the selected interns only for a few topics as mentioned in the list of the topics.
- vi. No stipends will be provided unless mentioned specifically.

Resolution: Approved.

i) Policy on Procedure for Processing the Cases of UG / PG / Ph. D. Students Visiting Abroad for Participation in Academic / Institutional Activities.

In order to help a student to broaden his/her horizon and gain course/work experience, the UG / PG / Ph. D students can be permitted to visit abroad for Academic/Institutional activities to carry out field work, computational work, experimental work, internship and also to attend conference, short term courses and to undertake other research works etc. as recommended by the respective department. Permission for a duration up to 60 days (preferably during vacation) may be sanctioned by the Dean UG/PG on the recommendation of the Department. Such permission can be granted only once during a UG/PG/ PhD programme. Only following students are eligible:

- UG : who have spent at least two years in the Institute.
- PG : who have spent at least one year in the Institute.

Ph.D: who have spent at least one year and completed the course work.

Resolution: Approved.

j) Minor Programme (UG)

- i. From Fifth Semester onwards students pursuing B.Tech. programme will have an option to select a prescribed basket of additional courses of minimum 20 credits to get a minor from another department or specialization within the parent department provided they fulfill the following criteria:
- ii. CGPA at the 4th semester is \geq 7.5
- iii. Have cleared all the courses in one attempt.
- iv. However, in Grade Card, Minor and In-Depth Specialization courses will be recorded as an additional course. The degree in Minor or the In-Depth Specialization will be awarded only on the successful accumulation of 18 20 credits.

Resolution: Approved. Each additional course could be awarded 4 credits instead of 3 credits.

105.04 Recommendations of Advisory Committee for Academic Programme (ACAP)

Advisory Committee for Academic Programme (ACAP) in its 43rd, 45th & 46th meeting held on 07th January, 2021; 27th January, 2021 & 04th March, 2021 respectively recommended the following agenda items, which were already approved by the Honourable Vice-Chancellor:

a) Summer Training Guidelines UG VI Sem CBCS Course.

After the completion of the summer training, the students need to prepare a report certified by the training organisation. Each department of the Institute shall constitute an Evaluation Committee to conduct the viva-voce of these students within 01 month of reporting to the institute after the completion of the summer training.

- i. Progressive Evolution (50%) : based on report
- ii. End Semester Evaluation (50%) : based on viva conducted in the department by a committee.

Resolution: Ratified.

b) Grade Card for the Minor and Mainstream (UG).

Once a student gets registered in Minor/ In-Depth Specialization courses registered along with the grades (excluding F-grade) obtained shall be recorded under Additional Courses in his/her Grade Card. However, the credit contribution of these additional courses shall be considered as NIL for the computation of the CGPA. When the students fulfill the criteria of required credits in the form of Additional Courses it shall be counted in favour of Minor/In-Depth Specialization.

The final transcript shall only show the basic CGPA corresponding to the minimum requirement for the degree. The Minors/ In-Depth Specialization courses will be listed separately in the transcript and will be indicated by a separate CGPA.

In-Depth Specialization will be reflected in the Degree Certificate as "B.Tech. in ABC with Specialization in XYZ. Similarly, Minor as "B.Tech. in ABC with Minor in XYZ.

Resolution: Ratified.

c) Make-up Exam.

Some subjects have prerequisite requirements. Therefore, a student having backlog(s) cannot register in a course that has a prerequisite in the lower semesters. Such backlog cases need immediate attention otherwise unregistered papers along with the backlog(s) would go on accumulating with the progression of the semester. However, provision of Make-up Exam may minimize this problem to a greater extent.

The Make-up Exam may be conducted within a short period just after the declaration of results. This would necessitate the completion of the re-evaluation process to be completed within a week after the result declaration, which should be followed by the Make-up Exam in which a student can reappear in the backlog courses. The total process should not take more than 15.20 days and should be completed before the registration of the next semester.

Above mentioned process can be initiated only after the evaluation process is decentralised.

Resolution: Ratified.

d) Decentralisation of the Evaluation Process.

ACAP recommended for the decentralisation of the evaluation process. Committee members are also of the opinion that the process of coding and decoding should be dropped.

Resolution: Ratified. The same be implemented with due diligence.

e) Selection Criteria for Sponsored Candidates.

To enhance the Institute-Industry interaction, it was decided to revamp the selection criteria for sponsored candidates to PhD program. To offer more weightage to the experience component of the candidates, it was decided to give 100 marks for interview and 40 marks for entrance examination, keeping other criteria same:

The committee members also put forward that for the candidates belonging to the sponsored category, the reputation of the company or organization where the candidate is working should be given prime importance. The name and reputation of the company/organization shall be scrutinized by the ACAP, before finalization of the selection list.

All other rules/norms of the Institute regarding part time Ph.D. students shall be applicable.

Resolution: Ratified.

f) Refund of Fellowship Amount/Bond for IRFS.

The motive behind Institute Research Fellowship is to enhance the research output of the institute. However, it is seen that few of the IRFs take the permanent withdrawal from the institute without completion of the thesis. To keep a check on this practice, the committee suggested a scheme where 25% of the fellowship of all the IRFs would be deposited in their name in the bank but under a separate head, on which they would earn the bank interest as well. This fellowship amount would be credited to the account of the scholar only after submission of the thesis. In case an IRF leaves the course in between without submission of the thesis, he/she would have to forfeit the 25% of the fellowship amount he/she has received which was deposited under separate head in the bank.

Resolution: Ratified.

105.05. Department of Architecture

Departmental Policy Committee (DPC), Departmental Academic Committee (DAC) and Board of Studies (BoS) in its meeting held on 21/01/2021 and 22/02/2021 respectively proposed syllabus of M.Arch. with 74 credits coherent to the structure given by Council of Architecture (COA) and BIT Mesra.

Approval of the Academic Council is sought

Resolution: The members of the Academic Council perused the details of CBCS curriculum for M.Arch. (Sustainable Architecture) to be effective from Academic Year 2021-22 and Approved the same with advice to the department to concentrate on regaining the earlier ranking position and improving it further.

105.06. Department of Bioengineering Departmental Policy Committee (DPC) in its meeting held on 24/02/2021 proposed the following agenda:

i) Eligibility Qualification for B.Tech in Biotechnology.

Considering the eligibility criteria for B.Tech. in Biotechnology by NTA-ICAR and eligibility criteria for Engineering and Technology mentioned in AICTE Approval Process Booklet (2020-21), it is suggested that students with Biology background should also be considered for the admission in B.Tech. in Biotechnology in the institute. The relevant documents of "AICTE Approval Process Handbook (2020-21)" and "Information Bulletin for ICAR AIEEA (UG)-2020" are attached for the reference.

Thus, it is suggested that apart from taking students through JEE (Mains), NEET and ICAR AIEEA (UG) qualified candidates should also be considered for B.Tech. in Biotechnology.

ii) Proposal for change in name of the Department.

For the larger acceptability, the name of "Department of Bio-Engineering" should be renamed as "Department of Biotechnology and Bioengineering)".

Resolution: The Academic Council aproves the proposal in principle as it complies with the AICTE norms.

In case required, Bridge-courses be conducted for students admitted with Biology background.

The Academic Council approves renaming of the department as "Department of Bioengineering & Biotechnology" with programme name as B. Tech. Biotechnology.

105.07. Department of Chemical Engineering

Departmental Policy Committee (DPC) and Board of Studies (BoS) in its meeting held on 17/02/2021 and 22/02/2021 respectively proposed the following agenda:

- Merging of two Undergraduate programmes namely: B.Tech. Chemical Engineering (60 intakes) and B.Tech. Chemical Engineering-Plastics and Polymers (60 intake) to single programme i.e., B.Tech. Chemical Engineering with 120 intakes.
- ii) Incorporation of Polymer Science and Engineering as Departmental specialisations with approval of relevant curriculum restructuring.

The students taking Exit-Option shall not be entitled for any kind of fee refund.

105.09. Department of Computer Science and Engineering

- i) Increase the seats of M.Tech. CSE from 16 to 30.
- ii) Restructuring of seats of M.Tech.(IS) from 18 to 9 (or whatever number AICTE guideline recommends)

Departmental Meeting, Departmental Policy Committee and Board of Studies (BoS) in its meeting held on 18/02/2021, 19/02/2021 and 22/02/2021 respectively deliberated that admission in the two M. Tech. Programme i.e., CAAD and Energy Technology in last three years are found to be very low in admissions, which may adversely affect the NBA, NAAC accreditation process and NIRF ranking of the Institute.

Therefore, it was proposed that the number of intake seats in PG Programme of Energy Technology and Computer Aided Analysis and Design are to be reduced by 50% (9 seats from each category).

Addition of a new Programme Elective subject: A new theory paper **"PE 324 Surface Engineering and Laser Additive Manufacturing"** is introduced as a programme Elective course for the Sixth Semester of the B.Tech Production Engineering Course Curriculum. (As per BOS meeting held on 30/12/2020).

b) Revision of a course:

Revision of a Programme Core subject • **PE 304 Production & Operations Management**: The syllabus of theory paper "PE 304 Production & Operations Management" (B.Tech Production Engineering Course Curriculum) has been revised as per BOS meeting held on 30/12/2020.

c) Reduction of Seats of M.Tech. in Automated Manufacturing System from 25 number of Seats to 12 number of Seats:
